What's New @ NKCPL

This has been a year of change and adjustment. Some things continue to look slightly different than before the pandemic, but we continue to move towards a new normal. This year saw the library reopen the doors of the building to the public and resume many of the services that were suspended. Here are some of the highlights from the past year.

New Technology

Technology Mini-Grant – Wi-Fi Access Points

In December of 2020 the library was awarded a technology mini-grant from the State of Missouri to purchase 8 Xirrus Wi-Fi Access Points, 15 barcode scanners, and 8 receipt printers.*

Winter Concert

NKCPL and NKCHS worked together to provide a virtual music performance by the Northtown orchestra and choir students. The community was able to enjoy this holiday entertainment by accessing a link to the performance which was published on our website and Facebook page.

Book Walk Addition

This year with the assistance of the NKC Parks Department a second Book Walk location was added at Macken Park. This original Book Walk location around the library also returned. The Book Walks consist of pages from a children's book attached to signs which were placed in the ground. Families can read and exercise at the same time!

Yoga in the Park program

NKCPL and the NKC Parks Department partnered to hold a series of yoga in the park sessions. These free yoga sessions proved to be very popular and a second series was added continuing this program through the summer and into the fall.

Changes in Administration

This year also saw the retirement of Vickie Lewis as NKCPL Director after 14 years of service. Lori Mangan took over this position and Doris Rogers was appointed as Assistant Director.





North Kansas City Public Library received the *Library Journal* Star Library Award

Library Collection & Statistics


Collection Expenditures
