What's New @ NKCPL

This has been exciting year for NKCPL with many positive changes and offerings. Below is a list of a few of these improvements and programs.

Technology Mini-Grant – AWE Station Replacement

In November of 2021 the library was awarded a technology mini-grant from the State of Missouri to purchase 4 AWE Early Literacy stations for public access use. The State portion of the LSTA grant funds requested covered the entire cost and no local funds were required.

Winter Concert

NKCPL and NKCHS worked together to provide a musical performance by the Northtown orchestra students. This event was held on the Lower Level of the library in December of 2021 and offered hot cider and seasonal music.

New Electronic Resources

The Missouri State Library has provided access to libraries across the state to new electronic resources. These resources were made available as online resources on the library website. The databases included Brainfuse VetNow, Rosen Financial Literacy, Rosen Digital Literacy, Book Connections, and Teen Health and Wellness.

Yoga in the Park program

NKCPL and the NKC Parks Department partnered to hold a series of yoga in the park sessions. These free yoga sessions proved to be very popular and were held from May through September. They were held at Macken Park on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Sensory and STEM Children's Programs

NKCPL introduced Sensory Storytimes as an option for families. These sessions, geared toward neurodiverse pre-k-aged children feature fun read-alouds and sensory play.

NKCPL also held regular STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) programming. These programs were held for preschoolers as well as for children in grades Kindergarten to 5th grade.


- NKCPL received a Star Library Award in 2022

- Seven Libraries in Missouri received an America's Star Library ranking




